BIOGRAPHY OF IRVING SCHWARTZ

The Eastside Branch Library is dedicated to the memory of Irving Schwartz for his devotion and service.

Irving Schwartz was elected to the El Paso Public Library Association Board in 1933. He served on the board for thirty-five years and functioned as president for twenty-five years. During his tenure, the current main library was built and the branch library system was developed to meet the needs of a growing city.

A native El Pasoan, Irving Schwartz graduated from El Paso High School in 1912. He then attended Columbia University. World War I efforts interrupted his higher education and he dutifully served as second lieutenant in the army field artillery.

After fifty years with the Popular, Irving retired and continued his career as a rancher and worked in Washington, D.C. for the Small Business Administration and Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Irving demonstrated his devotion to his community through the active roles he assumed in many civic organizations. His fondness for horses led to his involvement and leadership as president of the El Paso Polo Association. Irving served as president of the Rotary Club and was a recipient of their highest honor, "The Paul Harris Fellow". He also served as a member of the Yucca Council for the Boy Scouts of America, where he was awarded the Silver Beaver, an award given for distinguished service to scouting and dedication to the young people of the community. In gratitude for Irving's many civic endeavors, the City of El Paso bestowed him with the Conquistador Award.

Through his involvement at city, state and national levels, Irving Schwartz was consistently an exemplary citizen. It was his love of knowledge that inspired the creation of this branch of the El Paso Public Library System.

Irving was married to Soletta Manasse for over 50 years when he died in 1989 at the age of 93. Soletta died a year later. They are survived by four children and six grandchildren.

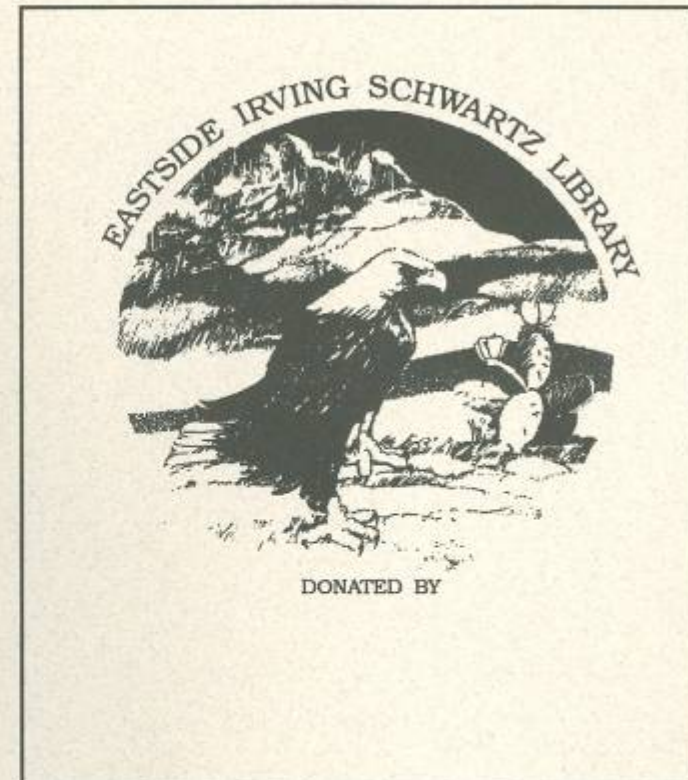

ABOUT THE STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

Irving was involved in artistic endeavors throughout his life. After a stroke at age 80 years, the fine work required for etching became too difficult so he turned his attention to designing stained glass windows. Four windows originally produced for family members and for close friends Tom, and Sara Lea, have been reproduced and donated by the owners. They are representative of the artist's interest in animals, the Southwest, Indians and sailing vessels.

Fred Griffin of Griffin Stained Glass Studio, El Paso, worked closely with Mr. Schwartz in fabricating all of his windows. He executed the designs to duplicate the original panels.

GIVE-A-BOOK



GIVE-A-BOOK is an ongoing donor program of the Irving Schwartz Library sponsored by the Friends of the Irving Schwartz Library. Each \$10 donation is recognized by a specially designed book plate showing the name of the donor and the recipient of the memorial or honor (if appropriate). Library patrons will recognize the eagle as a pen and ink rendering of the stained glass window over the front door of the building. The book plate is secured in the front of a new library book so that with each use the reader will be reminded of your generosity. Donations may be made in memory of a loved one or in honor of a special occasion like a birthday, anniversary or Christmas. Volunteers notify the recipient of your gift.
