



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Q: HOW DOES THIS WORK? IS IT ALL ONLINE? DO I NEED TO BUY BOOKS? IS THERE AN ACTUAL CLASSROOM TO ATTEND?**

**A:** Livemocha's courses do not require any additional books or physical materials. The coursework is completely available online, which means it does not come with DVDs or CDs. Therefore, your coursework is available to you no matter where you are - all you need is an Internet connection. There is no classroom to attend; you simply log in to Livemocha.com and work on your course as your schedule allows. How convenient!

### **Q: HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE A COURSE?**

**A:** There are 3 different types of courses on Livemocha:

- **Active English** takes an average of 400 hours to complete all 12 levels
- **Active French, Active Italian, Active Spanish, and Active German** each take about 150 hours to complete all 4 levels.
- **Vocabulary Builder Courses (all languages)** each take about 50 hours to complete all 4 levels.

That said, time to completion can range quite a bit from person to person -- it depends on your current language skills, how fast you like to work, how often you like to review past material and how quickly you grasp new concepts.

### **Q: HOW ADVANCED IS THE COURSEWORK? IS THERE MATERIAL FOR TOTAL BEGINNERS?**

**A:** All courses start at the very beginning -- from "Hello" and "How are you" and move up from there.

Each **Active course** (English, Spanish, French, Italian, German) has 4 levels (except for Active English which has 12 levels), and is designed to take you from beginner to conversationally fluent. This means you will be able to comfortably participate in a conversation with a native speaker - both listening and speaking.

Each **Vocabulary Builder Course** also has 4 levels, 101-202, and is designed to build your vocabulary and sentence structure in the language you are learning so that you can speak and understand at an upper intermediate level.

For all courses, if you are a newbie, you can start at level 1, or if you have more experience, you can start midway through the course.

## **Q: CAN I TAKE MORE THAN ONE COURSE? HOW DO I SWITCH BETWEEN THEM?**

**A:** You can take as many Livemocha courses as you want to! To enroll in a new course, mouse over the “Courses” tab in your top navigation and click “Enroll in a Course”. Then, select the language you want to learn in the “Learn Another Language” drop down in the top right corner of the page and select the course you’d like to start.

To switch between courses you are already enrolled in, mouse over the “Courses” tab in your top navigation and click “My Courses”. Every course you’ve enrolled in will be listed here – you can resume any course at any time.

## **Q: DO I HAVE TO LOG ON AT A CERTAIN TIME TO TAKE THIS COURSE?**

**A:** Nope! Our courses are completely flexible around your schedule - they are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at [www.livemocha.com](http://www.livemocha.com). You can choose when and how often you'd like to log in, and your progress will always be saved.
