

Procedures for the El Paso Senior Games Hall of Fame under the direction of the City of El Paso Parks and Recreation

These procedures supersede and replace all previous El Paso Senior Games Hall of Fame by-laws or procedures.

1. **Purpose:** To provide a process for the selection of two new members to the El Paso Senior Games Hall of Fame each year, one male and one female recipient.
2. **Selection:** A candidate may be nominated by previous Senior Games Hall of Fame inductees, by their own family members, or by the general public. Self-nominations are not accepted.
3. **Nomination Requirements**
 - A. Nominee must be fifty-five (55) years of age or older.
 - B. Nominee must have lived in El Paso County for at least ten (10) years, not necessarily consecutive.
 - C. Nominee must have competed in El Paso Senior Games for a minimum of three (3) years, not necessarily consecutive.
 - D. Nominee must follow the standards of good citizenship and good sportsmanship. Violation of any laws of moral turpitude could result in the removal of nominee or previously elected member of the El Paso Senior Games Hall of Fame.
4. **Resume**
 - A. The person making the nomination should provide detailed written documentation on the nominee's involvement and competition in city, state, and national senior games.
 - B. The nominee, if living must accept the nomination. This will be verified by Chair of the Nomination Committee.
 - C. Nominations must include two (2) photos; or reproduction of photos which will be retained and become the property of the El Paso Parks and Recreation Senior Games Hall of Fame.
 - D. Nominations must include ten (10) copies of the nominee's competitive background nomination. Newspaper pictures and articles are welcome and encouraged.
 - E. If selected for induction, the candidate or person representing the nominee must provide a biography for publication in the awards program (approximately 250 words).

5. **Committee:** Will be comprised of at least five (5) and no more than ten (10) members who are of local sports reporters from media outlets (TV, radio, and print), and one (1) nonvoting member representing the El Paso Parks and Recreation Department.
6. **Election:** The committee will convene once a year, by February 15th. At the meeting a Chairperson will be selected and candidate resumes will be read, discussed, and voted upon by committee.
7. **Voting:** Each committee member will cast a ballot for male and female nominees separately. The male and female nominee receiving the most votes will be selected for induction. In the event there is only one nominee, male or female, a Yes or No vote will be conducted for that particular category. A majority Yes vote will be necessary for induction. If there is a tie in either the male or female ballot, there will be a tiebreaker vote by those present to decide the selection for that particular year.
8. **Winners:** The two inductees will be recognized at the El Paso Senior Games Hall of Fame Awards Banquet with a plaque. A picture plaque will be placed in the Senior Games Hall of Fame Room located at Memorial Senior Center, 1800 Byron St.
